OC-215. (Update/Change) Budi, YF1AR, has changed his Indian Ocean IOTA Tour during the month of May because of bad weather. Look for him to be active as YF1AR/5 from Sipora Island (ARLHS IDO-379 Sipora LightHouse) in the Mentawai Islands IOTA Group between May 25th and June 1st. Budi states, "Sipora Island has never been activated before and more remote than Siberut Island from mainland Sumatra nearest city, Padang (capital west Sumatra province). It is 10.5% rare claimed." Activity will be on 40-10 meters using mainly SSB as well as some CW and Digital modes. Equipment is Yaesu FT 450D with tuner, 100 watts into a 40m vertical dipole and a HB9CV 20/15/10m antenna.
