FIJI, 3D2. Operators Stan, AC8W, Brian, KG8CO, Ted, K8AQM and Lee, N8LJ will be QRV as 3D2AC, 3D2CO, 3D2LJ and 3D2TR, respectively, from Tavenuni Island, IOTA OC-016, from August 24 to September 1. Activity will be on 160 to 10 meters using CW, SSB and RTTY. QSL 3D2TR via K8AQM and all others via K8ESQ.

TIMOR-LESTE, 4W. Wilbert, PE7T and James, N1YC are QRV as 4W/home calls until August 26. Activity is on 80 to 10 meters using CW and SSB. QSL 4W/PE7T via PE7T and 4W/N1YC via W5UE.
