30. On the motion of Dr. Boehner, seconded by Mr. Allen, it was VOTED that -

An optional paper certificate be offered for those who achieve Honor Roll, or #1 Honor Roll in the DXCC Program. In the DXCC Rules, Section 1 Basic Rules, part 1(u), the following sentence -

"Honor Roll qualifiers receive an Honor Roll endorsement sticker for their DXCC certificate and are eligible for an Honor Roll lapel pin and an Honor Roll plaque."

I have also checked the propagation forecast with various regions of the world, which allowed me to conclude firmly that the 20 and 30m will be the bands of interest for this expedition. In view of this, with help from George (VE3GHK), I have now a 20m monoband wire vertical with exceptionally low SWR on this band." QSL via VE3LYC direct or OQRS. The purpose of this experimental Web site is to provide 24-7-365 actual (REALTIME) band condition information to CW QRpp, QRPe and CW/SSB for Contesters interested in increasing their scores. It can also be of benefit to other Radio Amateurs to determine band conditions for Nets and casual QSO's. This information is NOT based on any software predictions or any kind of satellite based readings. It is based on a new Ionospheric sounding method called "HF Ionospheric Interferometry" which operates very similarly to the PolSAR system used by NASA.
