The purpose of this experimental Web site is to provide 24-7-365 actual (REALTIME) band condition information to CW QRPP, QRPE and CW/SSB for Contesters interested in increasing their scores. It can also be of

benefit to other Radio Amateurs to determine band conditions for Nets and casual QSO's. This information is NOT based on any software predictions or any kind of satellite based readings. It is based on a new Ionospheric sounding method called "HF Ionospheric Interferometry" which operates very similarly to the PolSAR system used by NASA.

The permanent installation of a 160m Inverted-L antenna and a Beverage is planned at the YS1YS club station. DX operation will be done especially during the night times from Friday to Sunday on 160/80/40 meters using SSB, CW and RTTY. The rig is a Elecraft K3 and a KPA500. QSL YS1YS via ClubLog or LoTW.
