3C0W, ANNOBON ISLAND. By the time you read this, operators Yuris/YL2GM, Kaspars/YL1ZF (ex-YL3AIW) and Girts/YL2KL will be preparing to leave Annobon Island. On their Web page it was reported on March 20th [edited]: "Yesterday set new QSO record - 5748 QSOs a day. Over 39700 QSOs in the 3C0W log in total so far. On Friday they will take down low band vertical, Spiderbeam and Folding antenna. Last night from Friday to Saturday they will be QRV on 40m and 30m bands. On Saturday morning they will end the operation, pack the remaining gear and fly back to Malabo. The flight home

is on Tuesday. No more 3C3W activity is planned during the days in between." On March 21st, it was reported: "Seeing the real situation of local kids in Annobon, the team decided to donate extra funds and extend time of fund-raising to support local pupils until Tuesday, March 27, 2018. The purpose of this experimental Web site is to provide 24-7-365 actual (REALTIME) band condition information to CW QRPp, QRPe and CW/SSB for Contesters interested in increasing their scores. It can also be of benefit to other Radio Amateurs to determine band conditions for Nets and casual QSO's. This information is NOT based on any software predictions or any kind of satellite based readings. It is based on a new Ionospheric sounding method called "HF Ionospheric Interferometry" which operates very similarly to the PolSAR system used by NASA.
