3Y0I BOUVET DXPEDITION NEWS. The only thing to report this week is that the members of the 3Y0I team continued to assembled in Cape Town, South Africa, for their anticipated Bouvet Island DXpedition. Specific dates still have not been provided yet, but all operators are now in Cape Town. Operators that have been mentioned so far are Dom/3Z9DX (Team Leader), Jose/CT1DSV, Tack/JE1CKA, Mietek/SP3CMX, Marcin/SP5ES, Stanislaw/SP8S and Branko/YU4DX.
