In this update, the 3Y0I team announced that the name of their ship to be used is called the "Atlantic Tuna", and also wished everyone a Happy New Year. They mention that the "Atlantic Tuna" is currently "being

refurbished from its very bottom to its top, meaning not only reconditioning of its hull but also any of the equipment installed onboard. All navigation, communication and engine systems are brand new, meeting the most demanding technical and safety requirements. Getting the ship ready is a time and money consuming process that requires a lot of patience and flexibility from us."
